



LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

IT IS OF VITAL IMPORTANCE THAT ALL GUESTS TRAVELLING WITH SEASONS IN AFRICA CHARTER CO. STRICTLY ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING LUGGAGE LIMITATIONS AND REGULATIONS.

All passengers travelling on our charter flights are entitled to one piece of checked luggage and one small carry on item, such as a handbag, clutch bag or daypack weighing not more than 5kg.

Due to the nature of the environment in which we operate, our aircraft are generally smaller than a typical airliner. As a result, we have much smaller luggage holds which results in weight and size limitations. The strict enforcement of our current luggage restrictions policy is in line with similar operations involving light aircraft transportation.



LUGGAGE SPECIFICATIONS FOR CHECKED IN BAGS:

LUGGAGE TYPE	Soft (all-sides) luggage/duffel bags with no rigid sides*
LUGGAGE WEIGHT LIMIT PER PERSON	20kg / 44lbs
LUGGAGE DIMENSIONS	40cm wide x 30cm high x 60cm long 16" wide x 12" high x 24" long

*Should travellers have bags with wheels please ensure that the frame supporting the wheels at the back is not a rigid/solid frame.

LUGGAGE SPECIFICATIONS FOR HAND LUGGAGE:

Should your luggage exceed the above limitations, we will **NOT BE ABLE** to load it. We do provide a **COMPLIMENTARY LUGGAGE STORING FACILITY**. Excess luggage remains the responsibility of the affected passenger at all times.

Oversized luggage **CANNOT** be carried on your lap. Your safety is our first priority and unsecured objects inside the cabin are hazardous.

Travellers who may require excess luggage must advise this at the time of booking. Seasons In Africa Charter Co. will advise on the availability of excess luggage dependant on the routing. Should an excess luggage option be available, it must be pre-booked and paid for on confirmation of their reservation. Additional luggage may not be an available option on the day of departure if this has not been pre-booked. Any additional luggage must still meet the baggage policy described above.
